Program

Friday 25th October 2024: Meet and Greet

Location: Wangaratta Performing Arts Centre

Time: 5.30 to 7.30pm

This event will provide all Entrants the opportunity to get together and have a chat in the beautiful Performing Arts Centre. Finger food will be served. Drinks available at bar prices. Tea and coffee available also. Following this event, there are many dinner options in the Wangaratta CBD, varying from restaurants to clubs to take-aways.

Saturday 26th October 2024: Monaro Nationals Show and Shine

For the pleasures for all our Entrants and families, as well as the public attendees, we will have setup at the Show and Shine a variety of food vendors as well as coffee vans.

Also as an option to look at apart from the beautiful Monaros on display we will have Market stalls attending with a variety of local produce, as well as kids rides and face painting.

Other market stalls will include Massage, clothing, Holden Merchandise and handcrafted products as well as a young local singer to entertain us all.

Saturday 26th October 2024 Partner and Family Bus Trip

For partners and family not wanting to spend the whole day at the Show and Shine. Departing the Wangaratta Showgrounds at 10.30am, we will proceed to the iconic country village of Milawa which provides a wonderful array of gourmet food specialty shops.

- Our journey will take us firstly to the Milawa Mustards -Gourmet Grocery Shop which produces a range of 12 seeded mustards ranging from Mild Honey mustard to Hot Chilli mustard. The range also includes seasonal condiments such as jellies, jams, chutneys, marmalades and mustard oil salad dressings. All of Milawa Mustards products are handmade on the premises, thus preserving the quality of this authentic cottage industry.

- We will then move onto the Milawa Bread and Kitchen all loaves are made on site using rye, spelt wheat and whole wheat that is milled on site.
- Next is the Milawa Cheese Company where a family of cheese lovers turned cheesemakers create mind-blowingly-good artisan cheese in Victoria's high country. Award-winning, small batch beauties for every kind of cheese lover - from creamy bries, to stinky washed rinds, to the freshest chèvre are on offer.
- Brown Brothers Winery is our next stop where you can participate in a Classic Wine Tasting - 5 wines of your choice from a limited list, standing session at the bar Cost \$10.
- Or, if you are not into wine, Milawa Township will provide an interesting place to browse, with shops including Milawa Bakery Café, Pure Indulgence Aromatherapy and The Olive Shop and Provender, specializing in olive and olive products, as well as all the best food and wine in the region.
- We will then return to Wangaratta for lunch, before arriving back at the Show and Shine by 2.30pm.

The Meeting point for this cruise will be the Wangaratta Air Field. With an arrival time from 9am for 10.15 departure, we will commence with a polka run on our way to the final destination of MOVE Museum, Shepparton. Lunch and farewells will follow.

Buddy pass – non judged car entry only – without presentation dinner - \$90, includes:

Additional Monaro entry fee - \$40

This option is only open to holders of a **full adult entry pass**. We reserve the right to ask Entrants to demonstrate their ownership of additional Monaro entries. Additional Monaros are eligible to participate in the Show and Shine only. If people want their additional Monaro to participate in the Driving Events, then a full adult entry pass is required. **Please email 2024nationals@monaroclubvic.com.au advising you wish to enter an additional Monaro(s) and you will be provided with an additional on-line entry form to be filled out and payment made.**

The Additional Monaro entry fee does not include access for another person to the Meet and Greet, Show and Shine, Presentation Dinner, Winton Raceway, Farewell lunch at Shepparton motor museum or an Entrant Shirt.

2. Judging Process & Classes

The 2024 Monaro Nationals judging Team has reviewed judging processes used at past Monaro national events as well as other national car events to determine an efficient and effective process to judge upwards of 300 Monaro's.

Judging this many cars will require considerable organisation and timetabling to ensure that all cars are properly assessed. Your cooperation will be essential.

The Process

Entrants will need to review the **Judging class entry matrix** BEFORE entering the event.

Scrutineering will be done over 2 days (Thursday and Friday) Final judging conducted at the Show and Shine on Saturday.

When you complete our on-line event registration, you will be required to select the appropriate judging class for your car, so it is important that you are satisfied with the judging class to use prior to registering for the event.

Self-Class Selection

This will ensure that your Monaro is entered into the correct judging class so that the Judging Team can create the scrutineering timetable prior to your arrival at the event.

Included in the 2024 Monaro Nationals Judging Manual (see download link below) is a detailed class entry matrix (see link below) that will guide you through a process to select the correct judging class for your Monaro. Once you have selected your judging class via the class entry matrix, you should read and thoroughly understand the class description details as your car will be judged against these criteria.

Note: 2024 Monaro Nationals Judging Manual currently not available, use the Class Entry Matrix below to select the correct category.

Your car details and the photo that you enter into our registration system will be assessed prior to the event by the Judging team. The Judging Team may make recommendations to the entrant to change their judging class, this is to ensure the entrant has the greatest opportunity of the awards on offer.

All entrant vehicles will be scrutineered on Thursday and Friday of the event. To ensure the entry process is complete, and the classification is as correct as is possible for each entrant.

Judging Categories

1.	Survivor	Open to all models.
2.	Concours	Open to all models.
3.	Factory Authentic	Open to all models.
4.	Factory Improved	Open to all models.
5.	Mild Custom	Open to all models.
6.	Street Modified	Open to all models.
7.	Show	Open to all models.
8.	Competition / Race	Open to all models.

9.	Special / Exhibition	Open to all models.
10.	Replica / Tribute	Open to all models.
11.	Export	Open to all models.

Note: The 20 year restriction for Concours and Survivor categories only have been removed and replaced with a 1000km per year restriction.

Judging Timetable

Scrutineering (Day 1):	Thursday 24th October, 2024.
Scrutineering (Day 2):	Friday 25th October, 2024.
Final Judging	Saturday 26th October, 2024.

Time management will be a key element of the scrutineering process. Once event registration closes on 24th July, 2024, the Judging Team will produce a time table for scrutineering on the Thursday 24th October and Friday 25th October. Each entrant will be allocated an approximate time.

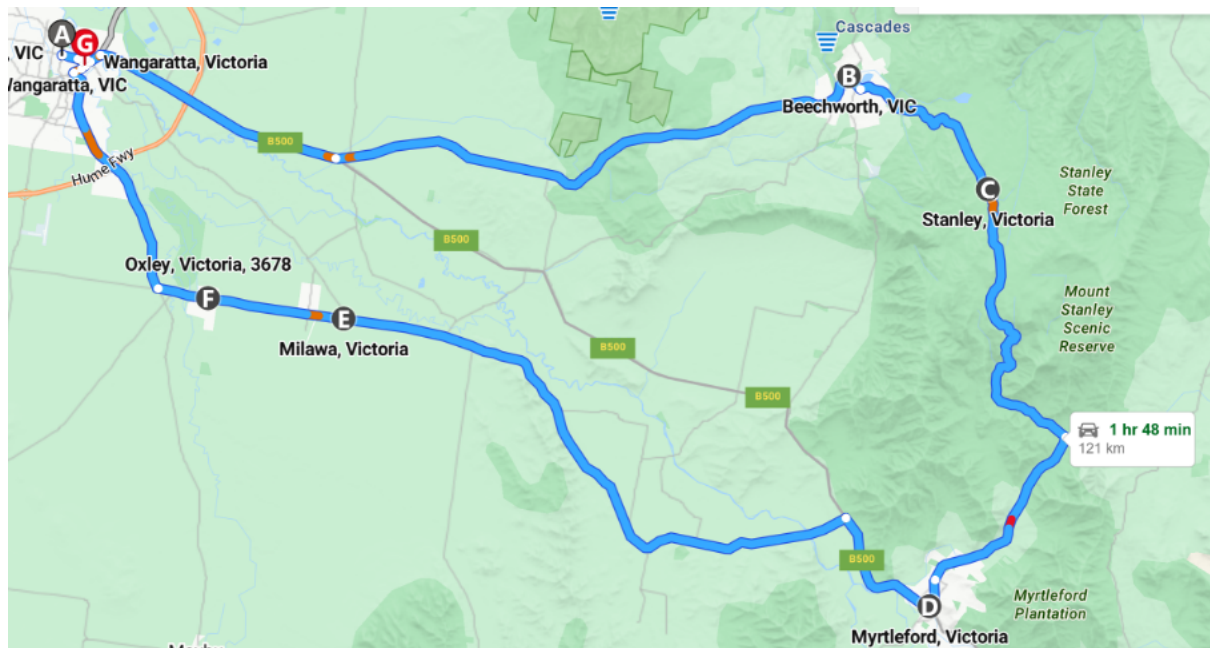

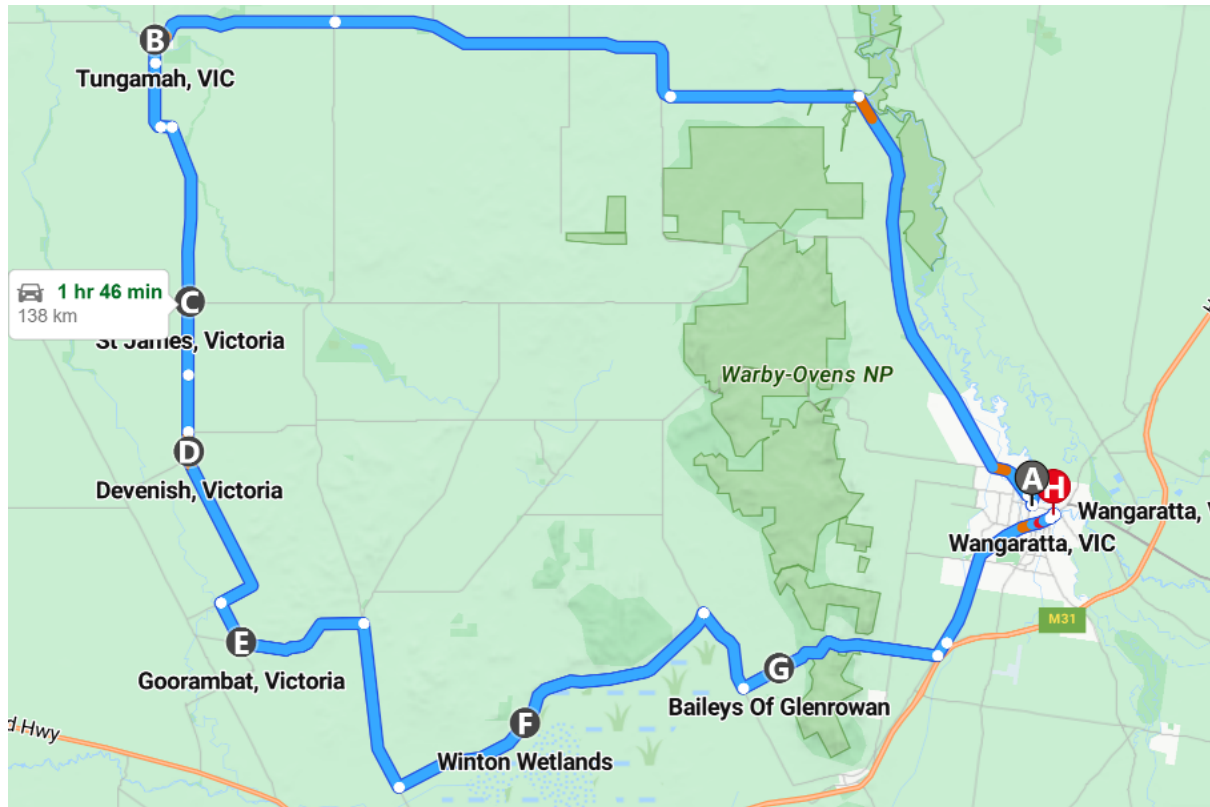

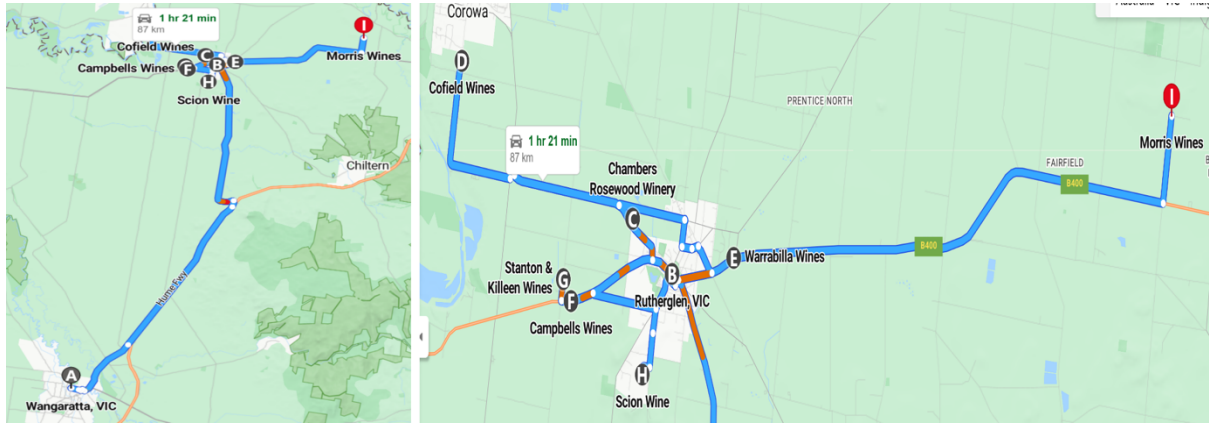

6. Frequently Asked Questions

Entering the event

Q. What is the latest date I can register to participate in the 2024 Monaro Nationals?

A. Entries for the 2024 Monaro Nationals close on the **24th July, 2024**. This date has been determined by the ordering date to place orders for the event merchandise.

Q. How were the entry costs determined?

A. Entry fees have been set to ensure that costs for the hire of venues, catering, security, trophies, merchandise, etc are fully covered. We have tried to keep entry costs similar to previous Monaro Nationals.

Q. I've paid for my attendance at the 2024 Monaro Nations, but I need to withdraw. Is my payment refundable?

Judging

Q. Can I enter my Monaro in a Category I believe is best suited for my car?

A. Yes, however the 2024 Nationals subcommittee may recommend a category that better matches your vehicle to the specified judging categories. If you decide to enter into a different category Judges will heavily deduct points for items that are not relevant in the judging process for that category.

Q. Where can I get more information on the judging category I should enter?

A. The judging manual will be finalised in Dec 2023 and will be able to be downloaded from the registration page.

On-line entry system

Q. Is there a paper entry form I can use?

A. As we expect upwards of 300 cars to enter the event with potentially 500 entrants, buddies and children attending, manually collecting and managing entrant, car details required for judging and taking payments would be overwhelming. Therefore, we have taken the decision to process all entries and payments via an on-line system. If entrants have trouble using the on-line system, send us an email at 2024nationals@monaroclubvic.com.au with your phone details and we will call you back and walk you through the registration process if needed.

7. Entering the Event

As we expect a large number of people and cars to enter the 2024 Nationals, the Monaro Club of Victoria will utilise an on-line event registration system to capture entrant's details. Here is how the on-line registration system works;

The on-line entry system has a number of sections:

1. Your contact details - if you previously joined our email update list, your contact details will be filled in automatically
2. Your car details
3. Entrant, buddy and child passes required
4. Winton Raceway pass - this can be added to your entry later if you are not sure about participating
5. Acceptance of event Terms and Conditions of entry to the event

[The Terms and Condition of Entry you will be asked to accept can be reviewed here.](#)

Some data fields in the sections require text entry, eg name, contact number, etc while other fields have drop-down boxes, eg to select model series – HK, HT.... VZ, etc.

The “Your car details” section requires information to support the scrutineering and judging process so care should be taken to provide accurate information. You will be asked to attach a photo of your car – a front offset view is required.

The “Entry passes required” section allows you to select the number of buddy passes and child entry passes you need in addition to you as the “Entrant” You can also choose your entrant shirt size here and advise of any special dietary requirements.

The “Winton Driving Event ” sections allows you to secure a place in this event. Entry is included in the full adult entry price.

Most of the fields are “required fields” where data needs to be entered or a choice made before your entry will be accepted. Once your info is entered, you will be able to hit the “Submit” button. You can then review / edit the info you have entered and then you need to pay on line with either Paypal or your credit card. Once your payment goes through, you will receive an entry confirmation email that will include all the details you entered.
